

TOWN OF CHRISTIANA
Regular Board Meeting
July 14, 2009

Meeting called to order at 7:02 p.m. by Chairman Rattmann, others in attendance supervisor Cutrano, clerk treasurer Brattlie, petitioner David Smithback, and other local residents-supervisor Kravik was not in attendance.

Posting of meeting was in the Cambridge/Deerfield newspaper and at the town hall.

Cutrano made motion to approve minutes of June 9th regular board meeting second Rattmann motion carried 2 ayes.

Motion by Rattmann to approve treasurer's report checks 12626 to 12658 second Cutrano motion carried 2 ayes.

Rattmann read June draft minutes of Plan Commission meeting.

Rattmann introduced Pam Dumphy from the Dane County Department of Transportation-citizens and town board asked questions and gave concerns about county roads in township. The main concern they wanted addressed was County Highway W-residents and board thought road has been in bad shape way to long and that culverts needed attention especially one by Swain farm which they noted could collapse anytime-repairs made to it were not holding up and they felt it needed immediate attention because there was still a hole in it. The Town Board will be sending letter to County Executive, the Dane County Highway Commission and County Board Chair so that county is aware of township concerns.

Cutrano made motion to approve David Smithback certified map and road dedication and deed restriction for remaining land zoned A-1 Exclusive on parcels 0612-063-8000-21, 0612-064-9000-9 and 0612-064-8500-6 to prohibit further residential development (petition 10040) second Rattmann motion carried 2 ayes.

Motion by Rattmann to pay part-time summer help \$9.00 an hour second Cutrano motion carried 2 ayes.

Rattmann made motion to take \$20,000.00 owed to London Lumber for salt shed out of one time Environmental Impact Fee second Cutrano motion carried 2 ayes.

Motion by Cutrano to pay bills second Rattmann motion carried 2 ayes.

Cutrano made motion to adjourn at 8:02 second Rattmann motion carried 2 ayes.
