**Regular Monthly Meeting**  
**March 10, 2009**

Chairman Lund called meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. others present supervisors Kravik and Cutrano, clerk treasurer Brattlie, Petitioner David Smithback and other local residents.

Meeting was legally posted at the town hall and the Cambridge/Deerfield newspaper.

Kravik made motion to approve the minutes of the February 10<sup>th</sup> regular board meeting second Cutrano motion carried 3 ayes.

Motion by Lund to approve treasurer's report checks 12453 to 12497 second Cutrano motion carried 3 ayes.

Kravik read draft minutes of plan commission meeting held on February 24<sup>th</sup>.

In public appearances citizens were concerned about unsafe driving conditions of Highway W-town chairman agreed and has addressed issue with county-it is not on next 10 year list to repair.

Town Chairman will address another letter to transportation department addressing issue.

Motion by Kravik to approve ordinance/petition number 10008 for Howard Lien & Sons, Inc./Verizon Wireless for property north of 2331 Highland Road at NW corner Highland and Koshkonong Roads parcel #0612-144-9500-7, CO-1 zoning District for wireless telecommunications equipment, prohibiting residential development second Cutrano motion carried 3 ayes.

Cutrano made motion to approve amended CUP 2099 for Howard Lien & Sons, Inc.-property north of 2331 Highland Road at NW corner of Highland Road & Koshkonong Road, parcel #0612-144-9500-7, for primary use communication tower for mounting of wireless telecommunications equipment-approval of 19 conditions from county zoning committee second Kravik motion carried 3 ayes.

Motion by Cutrano to approve rezone of 2 acres of land from A1-EX to RH-1 for David and Tammie Smithback for property located south 1469 Kraby Road for their daughter and son-in-law to build a home-deed restrict no further splits for residential development second Kravik motion carried 3 ayes. Kravik made motion to approve driveway permit number 91 second Cutrano motion carried 3 ayes.

Lund made motion to discontinue Sam's Club membership second Cutrano motion carried 3 ayes.

Motion to approve operator's license for Tina R. Alderman-for the Utica Bar second Kravik motion carried 3 ayes.

The Town Board decided to have patrolman Waag fill out agreement to purchase sodium chloride on WISDOT bid for up coming winter season.

Lund made motion to pay bills second Kravik motion carried 3 ayes.
