

**Town of Christiana
Regular Board Meeting
September 11, 2007**

Meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. by chairman Lund. Others in attendance included supervisors Kravik and Cutrano clerk treasurer Brattlie, petitioners Lucille and Scott Nottestad, Joe Arington, Helen Peterson and other local residents.

Meeting was legally posted.

Kravik made motion to approve minutes of August 14 meeting second Lund motion carried all ayes. Motion by Lund to approve special meeting minutes September 4 second Cutrano motion carried 3 ayes.

Lund made motion to approve treasurer's report August 31st balance-checks 11602 thru 11654 second Cutrano motion carried 3 ayes.

Motion by Lund to approve splitting off existing buildings on McClain Road with 5.3 acres of land from A1-EX to RH-2 for Joe Arington second Cutrano motion carried 3 ayes.

Motion by Lund to approve rezone of 2.2 acres McClain Road at Evergreen Drive from A1-EX to RH-1 for Joe Arington for new home site for family member-deed restrict no further development second Kravik motion carried 3 ayes. Lund made motion to approve driveway permit 82 for Joe Arington second Kravik motion carried 3 ayes.

Lund made motion to approve rezone of up to 4 acres from A1-EX to RH-1 parcel 0612-183-8330 for Lucille Nottestad/Scott Nottestad and on deed put property within ½ mile of gravel pit second Cutrano motion carried 3 ayes. Motion by Lund to approve driveway permit 83 second Cutrano motion carried 3 ayes.

Cutrano made motion for resolution opposing legislation creating a Dane County Regional Transportation Authority and Implementation of Commuter Rail second Kravik motion carried 3 ayes.

Motion by Lund for resolution urging the county to respect town comprehensive plans second Kravik motion carried 3 ayes.

Lund made motion for resolution opposing increase in county subdivision review second Kravik motion carried 3 ayes.

Motion by Lund to approve operator's license for Utica Association-oona Markielewski for 1 day October 7, 2007 second Cutrano motion carried 3 ayes.

Other Business-There was flood damage in Town of Christiana from record rain in August-residents reported damage to town clerk who gave out information on how to register with FEMA for assistance.

Kravik made motion to pay bills second Cutrano motion carried 3 ayes.
